Directions to Eastman Studio Theatre at Gallaudet University

Gallaudet University has *free* parking by the theatre building. The campus is also accessible by Metrorail (six blocks east of the red line NY Avenue stop) and Metrobus (buses servicing Florida Ave or 8th St.)

The campus entrance gate is located on the north side of the intersection of 8th Street NE and Florida Avenue NE.

When you enter, there will be a guard booth on your left. Simply wave at the guard and he or she will waive you on through.

From the guard booth, you will turn **RIGHT**, and the Elstad building will be directly in front of you. It has large windows and several doors across the front. This is the entrance to the lobby of Gallaudet's main stage, Elstad Auditorium, which is *not* where you are going.

For both the **Eastman Studio Theatre** and **parking**, continue just past the front of Elstad and take the **FIRST RIGHT TURN**. (If you go past the bronze bison you have gone too far.) You will be driving along the side of Elstad, and there will be parking on your right, most of which is handicapped parking. You can park in any of the non-handicapped spaces if they are open. The glass double doors on the left on this side of the building (the Elstad Annex) are the entrance for the **Eastman Studio Theatre**.

If you cannot park in one of the spaces at the side of the building, continue driving a short distance past the rear of the building, where you will see a large parking lot directly in front of you. You can park in any of those spaces. If you make a loop through the parking lot and have not found a space, you will end up driving down a ramp to the underground parking section, where there are many more spaces. (The ramp is in the southeast corner of the parking deck.)

You do not need a parking permit on weekends or after business hours, so, for our shows, it will be fine for you to park in any of these spots.
